ANDREW KERR

Andrew Kerr has been a dedicated and passionate supporter of nonprofit and service providing organizations throughout his career. In 2002, he joined with colleagues and friends to start Housing Works, a visionary nonprofit agency providing supportive housing services to chronically homeless individuals and families throughout Los Angeles County.

Kerr served as treasurer, financial officer, and vice-chair of Housing Works' Board of Directors. During his time at Housing Works, the agency grew from only one employee to a fully functional staff of 35 and a budget of over \$2.5 million.

Kerr was appointed to the City of Long Beach's Homeless Services Advisory Committee in 2014, helping to oversee the City's Homeless Services Division in the Department of Health, and he currently serves as vice-chair. In 2016, Kerr was appointed by Mayor Robert Garcia to serve on his Affordable and Workforce Housing Study Group. This group presented a series of recommended policy and administrative changes to the Mayor and the Long Beach City Council in the Spring of 2017.
