She was senior vice president and chief of staff to the publisher of the Los Angeles Times, where she oversaw staff operations and special projects. She served as senior vice president of external affairs with the Los Angeles Dodgers, where she oversaw the restoration of the Dodgers brand and the Dodgers Foundation.

Simril served in the U.S. Army as a military police officer in the U.S. and Germany. She was Deputy Mayor for Economic Development and Housing in the Hahn Administration, where she worked to expand rental and affordable housing in Los Angeles, and she was a Development Deputy to Los Angeles City Councilman Mark Ridley-Thomas, where she worked to help rebuild communities in South Los Angeles after the 1992 civil unrest.

Simril is currently serving on the Boards of Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce; United Way of Greater Los Angeles; Los Angeles Sports and Entertainment Commission; Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation; and the Board of Regents of Loyola Marymount University. In 2016, she was named to the Los Angeles Business Journal's inaugural list of The Los Angeles 500 Most Influential People.
